Our Residential Program

Three Phase Approach

Orientation

Residents learn about their rights and responsibilities while living at the shelter. They receive evaluations by professional Christian counselors, educators and ministers who assess their spiritual, mental, emotional, physical and educational needs. Each resident creates a personalized plan of action.

Transformation

Residents carry out their action plan while obtaining professional counseling, biblical education, academic guidance, personal wellness and life skills training.

Transition

Residents continue working on independent living skills as they move toward their new lives untethered from harmful substances, unhealthy relationships, and reduced dependence upon government assistance.


