Orientation

They receive evaluations by professional Christian counselors, educators and ministers who assess their spiritual, mental, emotional, physical and educational needs. Each resident creates a plan of action to complete while at the mission.

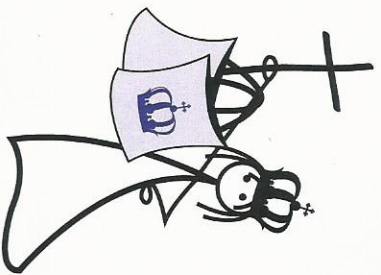
Transformation

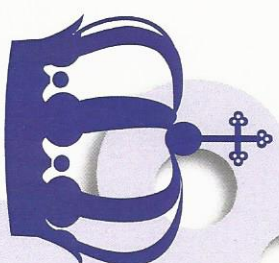
